



Kampong Phluk Floating Village By Tuk Tuk (half Day Tour)

Trip Overview:

The Tonle Sap one of the world's most productive bodies of fresh water. In the wet season, the Tonle Sap Lake swells to 12,000 km². During the dry half of the year, the lake shrinks to as small as 2,500 km², draining into the Tonle Sap River. Each year, millions of fish come to spawn in the seasonally flooded forest surrounding the lake, attracting a myriad of water birds as well as people, who have settled in villages along the shores and who live with the rhythm of the water. This ecosystem was classified as a Biosphere Reserve by UNESCO in 1997.

What's Included: Experienced and licensed English-speaking tour guide, transport by Tuk Tuk, boat on Tonle Sap and pier fee, bottle water on tour days.

What's Not Included: Travel insurance, meals, personal expenses

Pick Up Details: Pick up and drop off at hotel

Detailed Itinerary:

Depart your hotel for the journey through the countryside to the world's second largest freshwater Tonle Sap Lake. Take a boat trip to 'Kampong Phluk' a collection of three small fishing villages in an atmospheric flooded forest setting. Cruise through the village and see unique houses on stilts, and Cambodians at work in the floating forest. Our boat will meander slowly through forest canals, allowing you to catch glimpses of flora and fauna, and see a truly beautiful eco-system. Take the back-road back to town on this half-day tour in Siem Reap and witness seasonal agricultural activities like rice planting, and harvesting, smoking fish, fish paste (prohoc making), and duck farming. (Suggested visit period is between Aug to Feb).

Additional Information:

- Tour can be chosen between morning and afternoon departure
- Suggest visit period between August and February when the water is high enough
- Comfortable walking shoes are recommended
- No age limit
